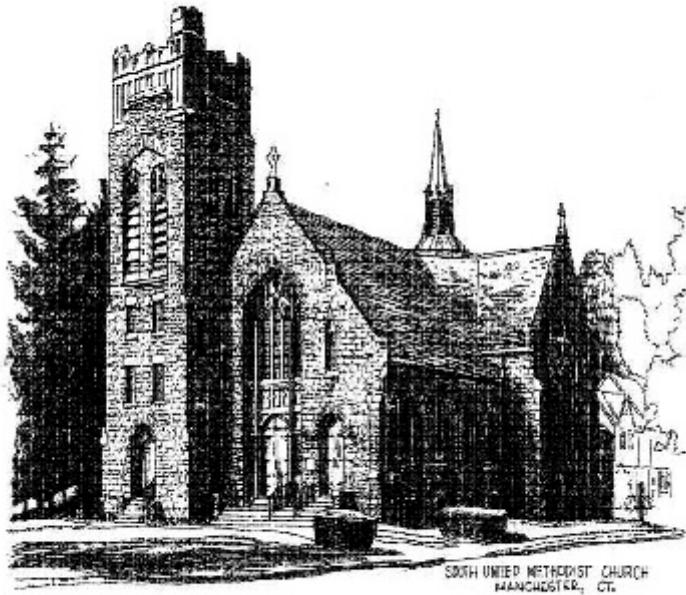

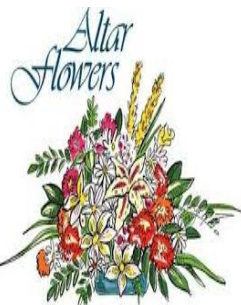
### The SUMC Drive-by MACC Bin

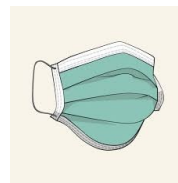

### CURRENT SUNDAY WORSHIP opportunities at SUMC



We will continue to live stream a modified service  
 for those not yet able to attend in person

**In person OUTDOOR** worship service,  
 following suggested CDC and local guidelines

~ **SUNDAY'S at 11:15am** ~

the location is on the side lawn of the church building  
 outside the outdoor pulpit.

~ **Please bring your own lawn chair or blanket** ~

**EVERYONE** will be responsible for sitting/keeping  
 at least 6 feet from those not from your  
 household.

Please note: **No entry will be allowed into the  
 church building** on Sunday mornings for any  
 reason, but port-o-lets will be available for use  
 outside if needed.

**Masks** will only be required if you are unable to  
 keep the suggested 6 foot distance from those NOT  
 from your household, but we anticipate since we  
 will be out side, they will not be needed.

At this time we are not allowed to provide any  
 refreshments so please feel free to bring  
**water/snacks** etc...

There will be at least **10 reserved parking spots**  
 for those with mobility issues, but still wish to  
 participate in the outdoor service. **All other  
 parking will be across Hartford Rd. in church lot**
