The **RE-OPENING** of SUMC; Phase 1  
As was indicated by Gov. Lamont  
recently, Houses of worship are now  
able to begin the process of re-  
opening for in-person worship for  
those who are not considered part of  
a "vulnerable population."

Pastor John has been in consultation  
with other local pastors in  
Manchester, as well as The New England Annual  
Conference to seek input and recommendations for  
beginning this process. He has appointed a re-opening  
team, which has been meeting to begin to set the path  
of a safe re-opening process for SUMC.

In the initial stage of re-opening South Church  
we will have limited church office hours  
**(BEGINNING THE WEEK of JULY 13)**  
Mon & Fri - 9am-Noon  
Wed & Thursday 5pm-8pm

(Please observe posted signs for masks and occupancy  
regulations for entering the church building)

**AND**

We will be offering 2 worship opportunities. . .  
1) Continued live streaming of a modified service  
for those not yet able to attend in person will  
move to 9:30 am (beginning Sunday, July 12)

**AND**

2) An in person **OUTDOOR** worship service,  
(following suggested CDC and local guidelines)  
**SUNDAY, July 12 at 11:15am**

We will meet on the side lawn of the church building  
outside the outdoor pulpit.

~~Please bring your own lawn chair or blanket~~

- \* Please note: No entry will be allowed into the  
church building on Sunday mornings for any  
reason, but port-o-lets will be available for use  
outside if needed.
- \* Masks will only be required if you are unable to  
keep the suggested 6 foot distance from those  
NOT from your household, but we anticipate  
since we will be out side, they will not be  
needed.
- \* There will be at least 10 reserved parking spots  
for those unable to leave their cars, but still wish  
to participate in the outdoor service. All other  
parking will be across Hartford Rd. in the church  
lot.
