The SUMC Drive-by MACC Bin

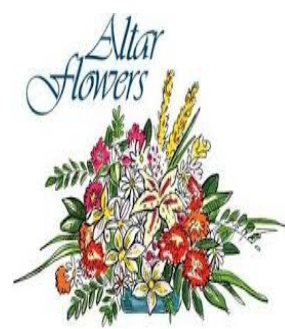

An **in person OUTDOOR** worship service,
following suggested CDC and local guidelines

Beginning **SUNDAY, July 12 at 11:15am**
the location is on the side lawn of the church building
outside the outdoor pulpit.

~ Please bring your own lawn chair or blanket ~

EVERYONE will be responsible for sitting/keeping
at least 6 feet from those not from your
household.

Please note: **No entry will be allowed into the
church building** on Sunday mornings for any
reason, but port-o-lets will be available for use
outside if needed.

Masks will only be required if you are unable to
keep the suggested 6 foot distance from those NOT
from your household, but we anticipate since we
will be out side, they will not be needed.

At this time we are not allowed to provide any
refreshments so please **feel free to bring
water/snacks etc...**

There will be at least **11 reserved parking spots**
for those unable to leave their cars, but still wish
to participate in the outdoor service. All other
parking will be across Hartford Rd. in church lot.
