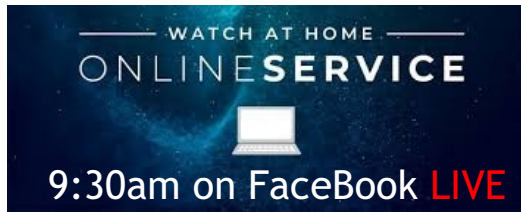

Praying with you all for a merciful end to COVID-19.

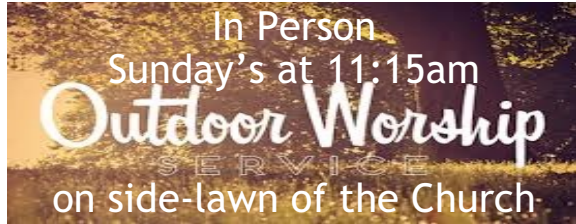
